I have been a wonderful sister it to you. What I said to the pediatrician I said because the burden of dealing with your many problems it's too much for one single person to have to deal with. I need professional help and I needed a professional to know that what has gone on the past five months is not normal.

I understand the situation with Steve is hard but it is the situation you chose. You should feel no fear of having your daughter taken away from you unless you are putting her in harms way. Your psychiatrist, the security professionals and your Family have all warned you that having Steve around could lead to an unsafe environment for Evelyn, and moreover, for you to lose custody of her. You have continued to allow Steve over the house and I have absolutely nothing to do with that.

You have to stop and think for a minute how lucky you are. You have \$60,000 in the bank. You have a healthy daughter. You have a business. You have an apartment free of rent for eight more months which is plenty of time for you to get back on your feet.

In private Caleb and I have talked about how sad it has been for us to relive Cleo's birth this past week. We couldn't hold her. We left the hospital \$10,000 in debt. We had bills to pay and not enough money to pay them. I have not had childcare for the entirety of 18 months that she has been my daughter. Every month, we struggle. I have done it all alone and it has been really really hard.

You have a night nurse and a housekeeper and people bending over backwards to suit your every need. You have had me doing whatever I can to help you make this process easier. But I'm done now. I want to let you know that I have blocked your number. If there's an emergency you can reach out to me via Caleb.

I will be willing to talk to you when you are ready to apologize to me for the hell you've put me through. For damaging my daughter, who twice now in her life has gone through the hell of being hospitalized. I am happy if you would like to come over to my house where I know things are safe and calm. Until then I wish you the best of luck. I will miss seeing Evelyn but I will not miss this chaos.
