


1           12.     As Petitioner points out, I willingly told Petitioner's psychiatrist, Dr. Gopal, that I  
2 had put Seroquel in Petitioner's wine, because I did not know what else to do: "sometimes when  
3 he is out of his mind on drugs and won't sleep I have put Seroquel in his wine."

4           13.     I regularly take prescribed Seroquel to help me fall asleep at night. **Petitioner has**  
5 **told me on several occasions that he has taken my Seroquel, in the same dosages, to also**  
6 **help him sleep at night.** Moreover, I told Petitioner after I put the Seroquel in his wine that I did  
7 it to help him calm down from his psychotic episode. Petitioner understood why I did this and  
8 told me it was "ok."

9           14.     On June 9, 2018, I was finally able to flee from Petitioner's domestic violence and  
10 return back to my home in New York. Ever since my temporary order of protection was granted, I  
11 have felt a sense of safety and relief.

12           I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the  
13 foregoing is true and correct.
